**Phytosanitary requirements for importation of canola Seeds  
(*Brassica napus* var. *napus*) to Iran**

1- **Procurement of valid phytosanitary certificate** from the country of origin in whose Additional Declarations (A.D) section freeness of the consignment from the following diseases has been confirmed:

1. *Leptosphaeria maculans*
2. *Plasmodiophora brassicae*

**Note:**

**Mentioning the scientific name of above diseases in the phytosanitary certificate of above consignment is mandatory; otherwise, customs clearance will be prevented due to insufficient documentation, any and all damages and losses being on importers account.**

- 1- Disinfection of the consignment with a suitable fungicide in the country of origin and mentioning its particular features in the relevant phytosanitary certificate.
- 2- The consignment must be free of dust and weed seeds.
- 3- Each part of consignment must be properly packed and labeled in which the scientific name of plant (type and species) should be mentioned.
- 4- Delivering the original phytosanitary certificate with mentioned requirements, as well as other necessary documents to quarantine experts at the time of investigating the consignment in destination border and customs clearance is mandatory. Otherwise, the importer will be found responsible for the consequences.
- 5- Transferring the consignment to domestic customs is only allowed after surveying and approving the original necessary documentation in the entrance customs.
- 6- If the consignment is exported via a third country, a copy of phytosanitary certificate of the first exporter country (with all mentioned requirements) stamped by the second exporter country officials accompanied by the original Re-exporter phytosanitary certificate must be presented to quarantine officials at the point of entry and to the customs clearance office.
